Number of US fiber-to-the-Home connections (as of September 2007): **2.14 million**

Approximate annual growth rate in FTTH subscribers: **112 percent**

Number of US homes passed: **9.55 million**

FTTH household market penetration in the US: **2 percent**

Number of US providers of FTTH services: **369**

World's leading economies in FTTH household market penetration: **Hong Kong (21.2 percent of homes with FTTH), South Korea (19.6 percent) and Japan (16.3 percent).**

Rank of US among world's economies in terms of FTTH penetration: **11th**

Percentage of US FTTH subscribers who are satisfied with their service: **84 percent**

Percentage of subscribers who say their FTTH connection enables them to work from home more often: **13.4 percent**

Percentage of US FTTH subscribers who are experiencing real download speeds of above 5 megabits per second: **60 percent**
