Ribbon Cutting to be held Aug. 3 for Bike Rack Donated by the Town of New Castle

On Thursday, August 3 from 5-5:30 pm, the Glenwood Springs City Council and officials from the Town of New Castle will host a ribbon cutting at the new bike rack, located in the parking lot of Summit Canyon Mountaineering. Summit Canyon Mountaineering is located at 205 6th Street in Glenwood Springs.

The City of Glenwood Springs would like to thank the Town of New Castle and Summit Canyon Mountaineering for their generous support and efforts to encourage alternative transportation during the detour. For the upcoming Grand Avenue Bridge detour to function, we will all need to do whatever we can to reduce the number of vehicle trips we make daily.
