### **Provide Feedback for Draft “Glenwood: Moving Forward Together” Plan Elements on March 20 City Invites Community to Comment about the U.S. EPA Brownfields Area-Wide Planning Effort**

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, Colo. – Community members are invited to review and comment on draft elements of the Glenwood: Moving Forward Together plan at a drop-in Community Workshop on March 20.

Draft analysis/elements of the plan will be available at topic area stations from noon to 8 p.m. at Morgridge Commons, above the Glenwood Springs Branch Library at 815 Cooper Ave. At the workshop, the public will be invited to learn more about the project and help guide the strategy to tie together the Confluence Redevelopment, 6th Street Corridor Master Plan, 7th Street Beautification project and Two Rivers Park. Presentations will be made at 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.

The “Glenwood: Moving Forward Together” Project – the U.S. EPA Brownfields Area-Wide Planning Effort kicked off in 2017 with community focus groups, community meetings and a design charrette. The consultant team lead by Stromberg/Garrigan & Associates is developing a draft implementation plan to revitalize the brownfields located along the Colorado and Roaring Fork Rivers in the City’s core, including a 5-acre site where the City’s decommissioned wastewater treatment plant is located. The planning area covered by the grant also includes the 5-acre CDOT Engineering and Maintenance site across Devereux Road from Two Rivers Park and the 27.4-acre Holly Quarry site near the Iron Mountain Hot Springs/Glenwood Caverns Adventure Park.

The project is made possible by a \$200,000 U.S. EPA grant to revitalize several brownfield sites located along the Colorado and Roaring Fork Rivers in the City’s core.
